The Mid-Atlantic - Eurasia Business Council (MAEBC/MARBC) is pleased to announce the Days of Eurasian-American Innovation Entrepreneurship Cooperation (RAVC 2015 and RAVC 2016), which will take place in Philadelphia and Mid-Atlantic Region on November 3-6, 2015 and on May 9-13, 2016.

As part of RAVC 2015, the MAEBC/MARBC is organizing the Eurasian – American Technology Entrepreneurship Conference. The Conference will take place in Quorum at

the University City Science Center (3711 Market St., Philadelphia, PA), the biggest and oldest urban technology park in the United States. This conference is a key RAVC event, and will include a roundtable featuring presentations from the company-residents of the International Incubator, including the Science Center's first Russian company-resident, Optiflame, as well as presentations about entrepreneurial innovation systems in Eurasia. RAVC 2015 will also feature a roundtable to discuss Eurasian-American educational technology cooperation. The Mid-Atlantic - Eurasia Business Council will also be facilitating Eurasian participation in the IMPACT Capital Conference (IMPACT 2015), one of the oldest venture capital events in the United States, which showcases young and developing companies and provides participants with a unique opportunity to access private investors and the largest regional venture funds. As in previous years, the MAEBC/MARBC is continuing its commitment to being a supporting organization of IMPACT, bringing a delegation from the Eurasian venture industry and emerging Eurasian companies to participate at the conference. RAVC 2015 events are a final part of the MAEBC/MARBC's 20th anniversary year celebration, and represent a continuation of the MAEBC/MARBC's twenty-year-long effort to develop Eurasian-American innovation entrepreneurship cooperation.

Key RAVC 2016 events will include a Ceremony at Philadelphia City Hall, the Eurasian-American Technology Entrepreneurship Conference, the Eurasian-American Life Sciences Innovation Roundtable, the Eurasian-American Innovation Technology, University Research & Commercialization Roundtable and Eurasian participation in the 2016 ACA Summit.
